

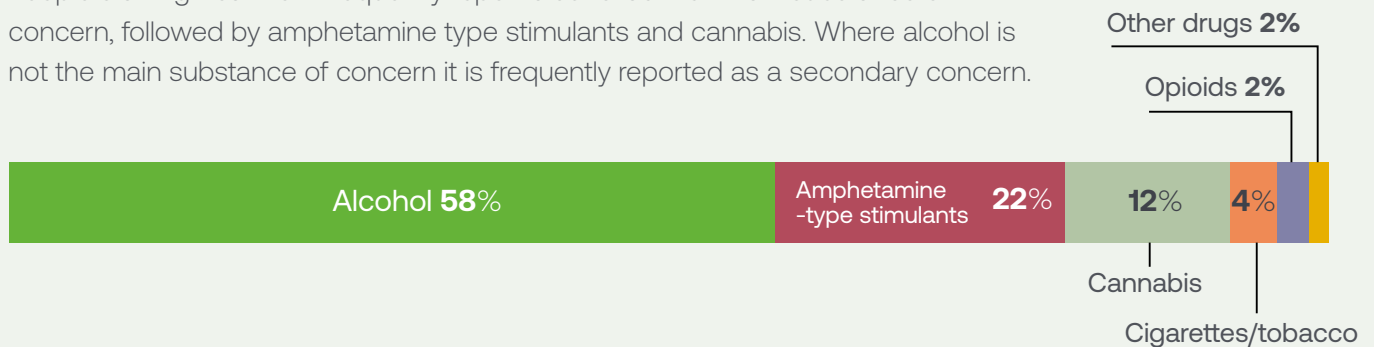
Alcohol and drug community services report card 2019/20

Main substance of concern for ADOM treatment start collection

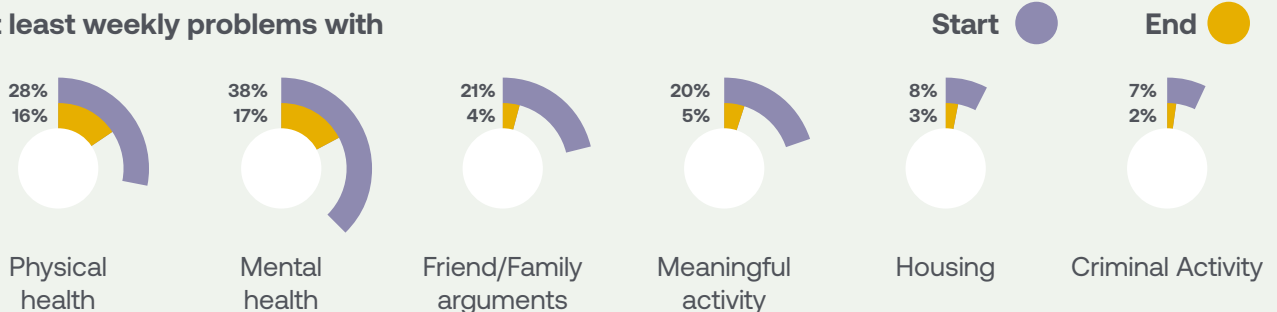
People starting treatment frequently report alcohol as their main substance of concern, followed by amphetamine type stimulants and cannabis. Where alcohol is not the main substance of concern it is frequently reported as a secondary concern.



Lifestyle and wellbeing matched pair improvement

Matched pairs refers to treatment start and end collections for the same people. For all lifestyle and wellbeing issues examined, there are obvious improvements for people following treatment in their mental health, engagement in meaningful activities and fewer arguments with family and friends.
