

Outcome report card for child and adolescent mental health services

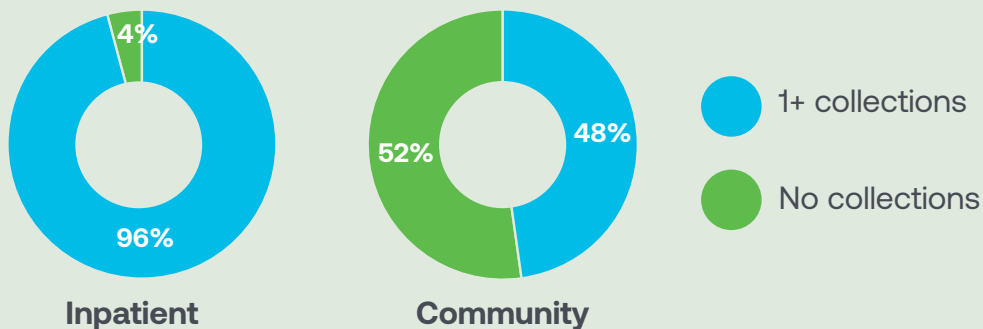
Refers to result from PRIMHD summary report HoNOSCA, National July 2019 - June 2020. For more information [read the report](#) and refer to the accompanying [user guide](#).

This report uses HoNOSCA (Health of the Nation Outcome Scales - Child and Adolescent). HoNOSCA is a simple outcome measure used in child and adolescent services. It has 15 items scored from 0 to 4 where 0 is no problem and 4 is a serious problem.



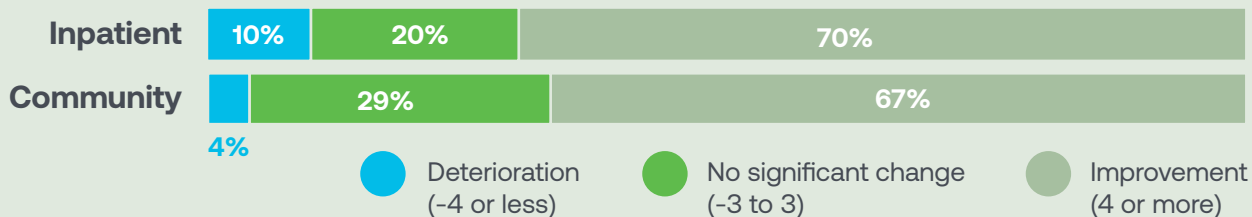
Outcome collection in a three month period (Apr - Jun 2020)

Currently it is meant to be collected with a 80% collection rate. For 4-17 years.



Change in total score from admission to discharge (Jul 2019 - Jun 2020)

Total score refers to adding all 15 items of HoNOSCA together. It uses matched pairs from admission to discharge for the same tāngata whai ora.



Index of severity while in service for different team types (admission and review)

HoNOSCA scores can be collated to indicate severity. For more information go to user guide.
